

## **Daycare survey in the Berlin district of Lichtenberg on the fields of action "Nutrition and Dental Health"**

### **Frequency evaluation February 2018**

From October to December 2017, the Institute for Applied Demography Berlin (IFAD) conducted a standardized written survey of the day-care center management and / or management in cooperation with the district office Lichtenberg of Berlin (organizational unit quality development, planning and coordination of public health or youth welfare / technical control). of daycare staff from all daycare centers in the Lichtenberg district. The content of the related questionnaire was developed in cooperation with the district office, the immediate preparation and organization of the survey as well as the field work on site was carried out by IFAD staff. After completing the survey in the daycare centers, the questionnaires were evaluated in the institute. The content of the survey focused on selected topics and fields of action of the Berlin child health goals "nutrition and dental health" and their evaluation should be used to stimulate and implement quality developments in the district.

After completing the field work (i.e. picking up the questionnaires from the daycare centers and registering them), evaluable questionnaires were available from 124 day care centers. With a population of 140 daycare centers in the district, this corresponded to a response rate of 88.6%. The individual data and data records were recorded for analysis using Excel data tables and checked several times, as were the approx. 370 text responses or verbal messages in the questionnaires. In addition to the data-based frequency analysis of all questions, the verbal answers to certain open questions (see questionnaire in the appendix) as well as verbal messages that were noted for individual questions in the questionnaire were included in the evaluation.

In terms of methodology, this survey is a total survey in the sense of an actual status analysis at the time of the survey (frequency analysis / text entry). No personal data were collected. The data evaluations for the individual questions of the questionnaire, which are carried out in graphic and text form below, represent the total frequencies of the net sample (124 questionnaires) and their distribution. The graphics refer exclusively to the respectively valid answers in the form of absolute numerical values or percentage distributions. Differences (positive as well as negative) to the total number of questionnaires (124) or the percentage distribution (100%) in the individual graphic representations result on the one hand from the possibility of multiple answers to certain questions or from the fact that individual questions in the questionnaire are not of all day care directors and employees were answered.

A short summary of the survey results and the respective text responses of the test subjects, which were summarized here in terms of content and smoothed linguistically, is assigned to the individual graphic representations..
